2024/25 Young Arts Administrator Fellowship Programme (6-month)

Spanning from October 2024 to April 2025, the scheme will provide fellows firsthand experience in event management with Toolbox Percussion, opportunities to work with emerging international composers, outing and lectures to inaugurate art practitioners knowledge and professionalism in art administration and management, transforming them into the next leaders in the industry.

Suitable candidates will gain:

- On-site event management experiences in our upcoming events, including ASIA+ and Toolbox International Creative Academy (TICA) Festival;
- Close collaboration with international composers/ finalists at the 6th Toolbox Percussion International Composer Competition (TPICC), in assisting them to land their Hong Kong premiere presentations;
- Lectures on programme curation, docentship, leadership and teamwork;
- Art appreciation outing activities.
- * The fellowship will also require participants to assist in office administration work when needed, which counts towards a maximum of 400 hours of commitment from October 2024 April 2025. Travel allowances will be offered.

We are looking for fellows with the following attributes:

- Bachelor degree or above in Arts Administration/ Cultural Management/ Cultural Studies/ or relevant discipline;
- Previous work experience related to event / stage management preferred;
- Self-initiative, proactive, dynamic, and able to meet tight deadlines;
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office and Apple iOS; knowledge in AutoCAD, Logic Pro and Ableton will be an advantage;
- Good interpersonal skills and a team player;
- Good written and communication skills in Chinese and English;
- Hong Kong Permanent Resident aged 18 or above.
